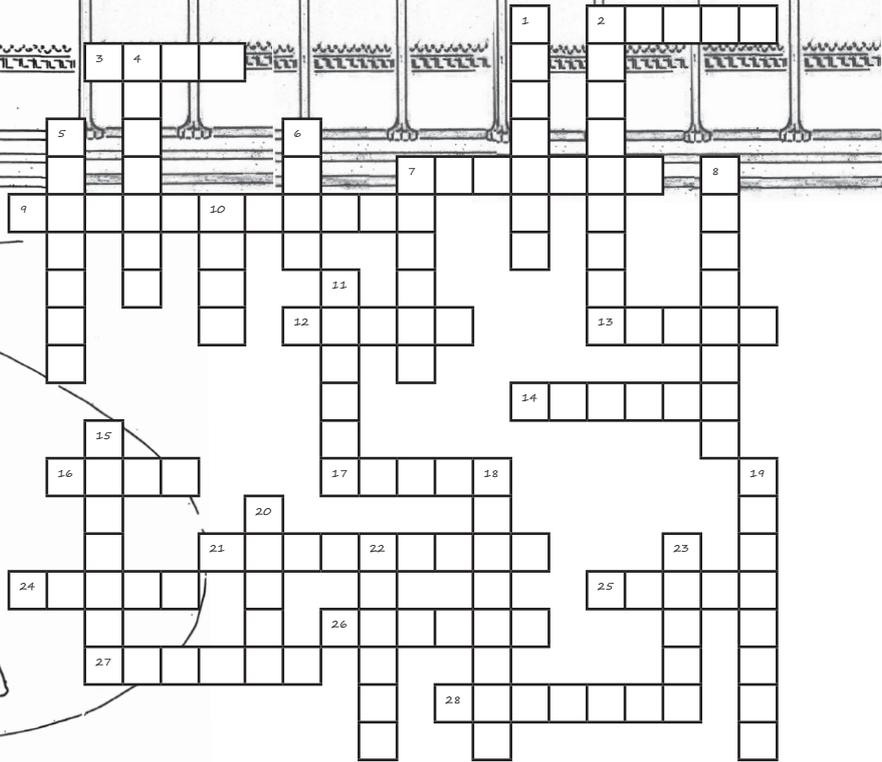
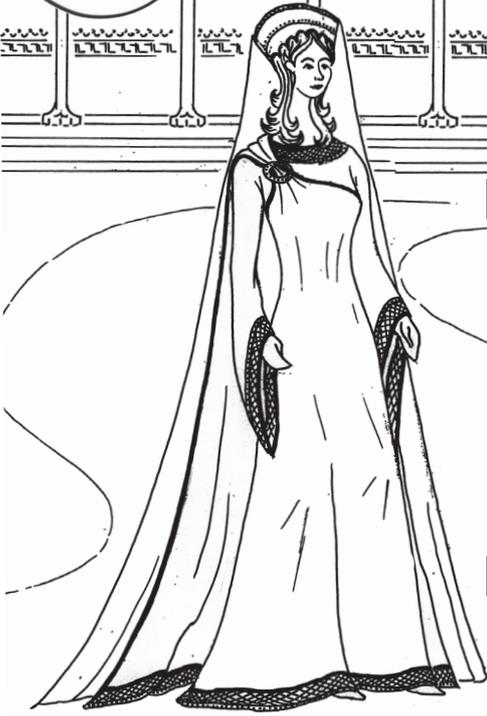

Challenge your teacher or a friend to a game of hangman. Your teacher can decide the best way to play. These rows of dashes represent names, places or important words from the book of Esther. The list of words is on the teacher's page. (Make sure you cover up the words not using yet!)



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HOW TO PLAY: One player (maybe the teacher) is the "hangman". This player chooses one answer from the list of suggested words then the other player guesses a letter which they think might be in the word. If they guess correctly, the hangman writes that letter on the correct dash(es). If the guesser chooses a letter which is not in the word, the hangman may fill in one line on the picture of the gallows next to the word. The guesser may then have another turn. There are two ways the guessing player can win; either by completing the word or by guessing the whole word before they have found all the letters correctly. The hangman wins if the picture of the gallows is completed.

We don't know what Esther, Mordecai, Haman and Xerxes looked like, but who do think is who in these pictures?
