Around the Middle East there have been many seals found like this one. Clay or wax would be put onto a document and the seal would be pressed into it. The pattern on the seal would identify the person who owned it and prove that the document was genuine.

Amongst the symbols on this seal are the letters YZBL which spell Jezebel in Hebrew, so it is possible that this was the seal of Queen Jezebel.

You could search the web for 'Jezebel seal' to find out more.


